ARTIST LISTINGS

This guide contains details of all artists, artist groups and schools taking part. Each entry is listed according to which Norfolk district they are in, and then by postcode. They each have a brochure ID number, so you can see where they are located on the maps in this guide (see p10). Simply select which artist you want to visit, check when they're open and make your visit. There's no need to book in advance unless you're a large group, and there's no admission charge for any studio.

CELEBRATING 25 YEARS

Welcome to Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios 2019 – the well-loved, annual art event that has been celebrating the wonderful diversity and creative talent of Norfolk’s visual arts community for 25 years!

In 1994 the local visual arts element of the Norfolk & Norwich Festival branched out to become its own stand-alone event. Still co-ordinated by the Festival, this new initiative was, in its first year, called ‘Visual Arts Week,’ with 49 studios and 15 galleries taking part. Now in its 25th year (and after one or two name changes) the event has 430 artists spread across 250 venues, as well as 19 Norfolk schools, taking part.

This FREE event sees artists and makers throughout the county opening their doors to the public, to exhibit, sell and talk about their work. You get the intimate opportunity to meet and chat to the artists, see their artwork and find out, first-hand, more about their skills, techniques and influences. You’ll find artists practicing a wide range of techniques, with specialists in printmaking, painting, drawing, ceramics, textiles, metalwork and much more.

Artists can be found in every corner of Norfolk, giving you the excuse to explore this beautiful county and visit a huge variety of inspiring work spaces, ranging from traditional studios to churches, garden rooms and old factories. If you want to make a day of it and combine several studio visits while exploring the county then follow one of the 16 Art Trails detailed inside.

This brochure lists everyone taking part across various geographical areas of Norfolk, along with their opening days and times. An alphabetical index of artists can be found at the back. All artist profiles, events and trails are also available to browse on our website: nnopenstudios.org.uk.

A big thank you to every single artist involved, some of whom have been taking part since 1994, and a few, even earlier! They continue to make this event one of the highlights of the year for so many. Thank you too to the various organisations that help support the Open Studios scheme. 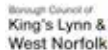

MEET THE ARTISTS

Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios offers a unique opportunity to meet a huge range of the county's artists – to find out more about what inspires them, learn about their processes and techniques, and to get an insight into their backgrounds and lives. For a taster of the stories behind the art, here are some short profiles of four of this year's Open Studios artists.

059 **Ernie Childs (PAINTER)**

I was born during the herring day era, in the Medieval Rows of Great Yarmouth. As a young lad I was fascinated with fishing boats and the sea, particularly stormy weather, and I remain inspired by all things maritime.

Maritime life remains the main theme for my art, however I also like to work lamp or candle light into by paintings and appreciate the change in colour that this provides. I use all mediums but I have a real love of oils, and enjoy the flow of oils on canvas. Some of my canvasses reach massive sizes and occupy private collections and public buildings far and wide.

My studio is in the 800 year old Town Wall. The rooms were fish gutting rooms and smoke chambers for the duration of the era of East Coast Herring Fishing Industry. Initially my wife and I took over the South East Tower and established a Potteries business here, and as the business grew we then took over the smokehouse next door. We restored the premises using shipwreck timbers gathered from the beach, turning the premises into a unique museum of artifacts from the fishing industry as well as the home and workshops of Great Yarmouth Potteries, which is now Ernie Childs GYPC (Great Yarmouth Painting and Crafts).

This is my first year taking part in Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios. I'm looking forward to meeting visitors to talk about my work and show them my studio space, as well as letting people know about the classes I run.



139 **Shauna Richardson (CROCHETDERMY®)**

Having attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder, also called ADHD or ADD, I knew very early on that my career was never going to fall into the academic category. I had always loved art and was seldom without a pencil in my hand, and so when I left school I began travelling and painting and hosting exhibitions on my return. Sales from these exhibitions enabled the funding of the next painting trip and exhibition. Later in life I studied for a BA and began exploring ideas through different mediums. In 2008 I created Crochetdermy®, a way of working that I still use today.

Crochetdermy® pieces are realistic life-size animal sculptures created using my own freestyle crochet technique. The first piece I made was a 7ft brown bear. Apart from relishing a challenge, it amuses me to witness people's preconceived images of crochet toys being shattered when confronted by realistic taxidermy-like pieces.

I have worked in various studios and locations over the years and where I work is generally dictated by the size of animal I am working on. At present I am working on a polar bear. An understanding husband and dog mean that I can accomplish this from the comfort of my own home.

I have recently moved to Overstrand in North Norfolk and it's my first year taking part in Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios. I'm taking part as I see the scheme as a good way to get to know the area and other local artists, as well as a nice way to meet people interested in my work.

165 St Etheldreda Studios (ARTIST GROUP)

St Etheldreda Studios are possibly the oldest consistently run artist studio space in Norwich. The disused former church was taken on in 1981 (38 years ago!) by a group of fine art graduates, graduating from what is now Norwich University of the Arts. This group of graduates included Michael Chapman, who still has his studio in the old church and who continues to help run the studio space, along with his wife Linda.

There are currently 12 artists working at the studios and between them they cover a wide range of mediums, including painting, sculpture, installations and ceramics. Michael himself works with 3D media and favours a constructivist approach. He is inspired by the belief that anything is possible as a medium and one of his recent sculptures was created from a dismantled filing cabinet. Linda Chapman works in 2D drawing media and with acrylic on canvas. Although she covers a variety of themes, they are often literary – Shakespeare's plays and characters have been a constant source of inspiration.

St Etheldreda Studios have been part of Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios since its beginning 25 years ago. The artists enjoy being part of a county wide event and feel it has helped to give greater awareness of how they use the historic space, allowing visitors to come and see the studios, meet the artists and enjoy the artwork.

261 Louise Stebbing (PRINTMAKER)

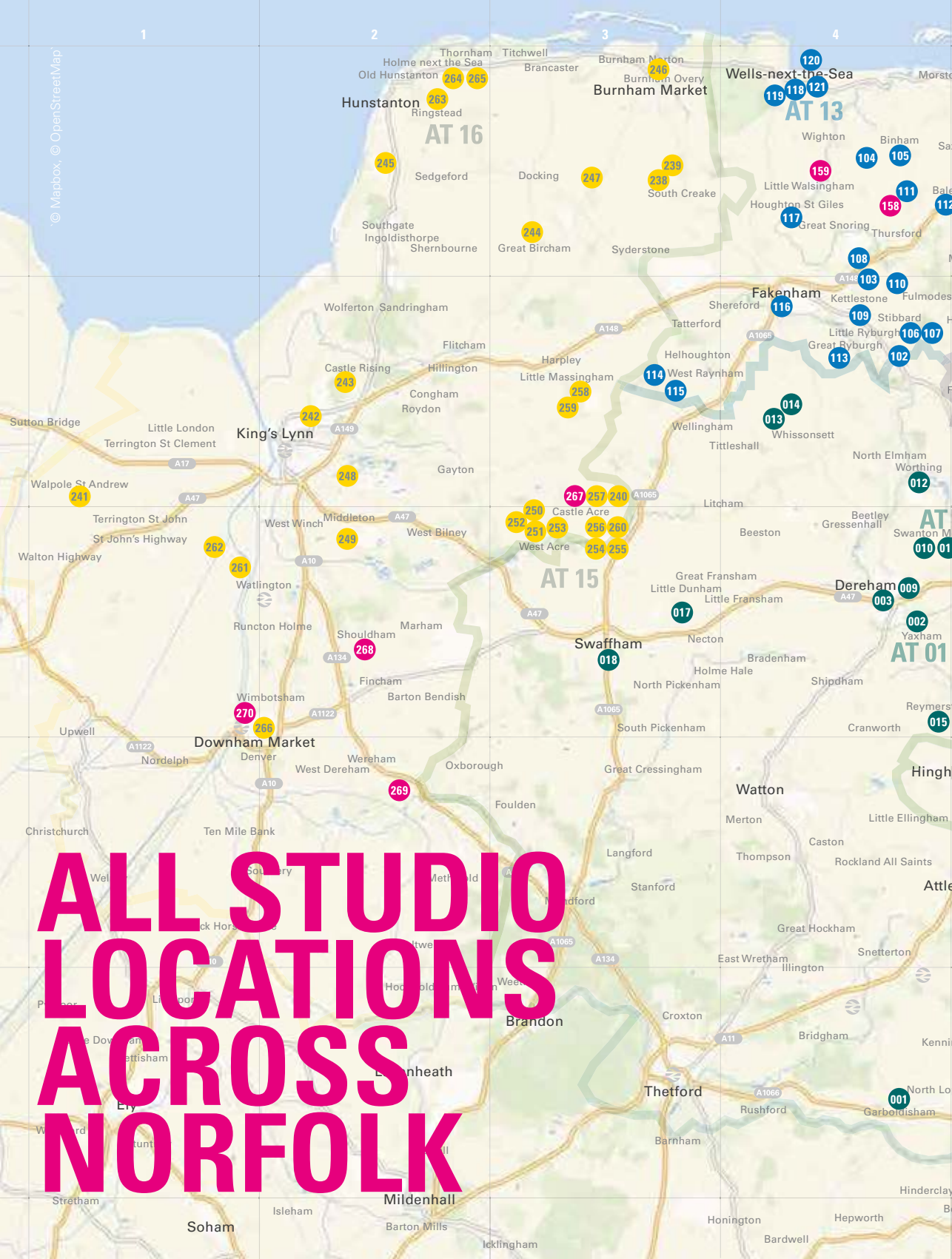
I discovered Printmaking during my Art Foundation course in Cambridge, which led to me doing a Fine Art degree at Sheffield, and then a Postgraduate Course in Printmaking at Camberwell. This was 40 years ago and I have been mesmerised by it ever since.

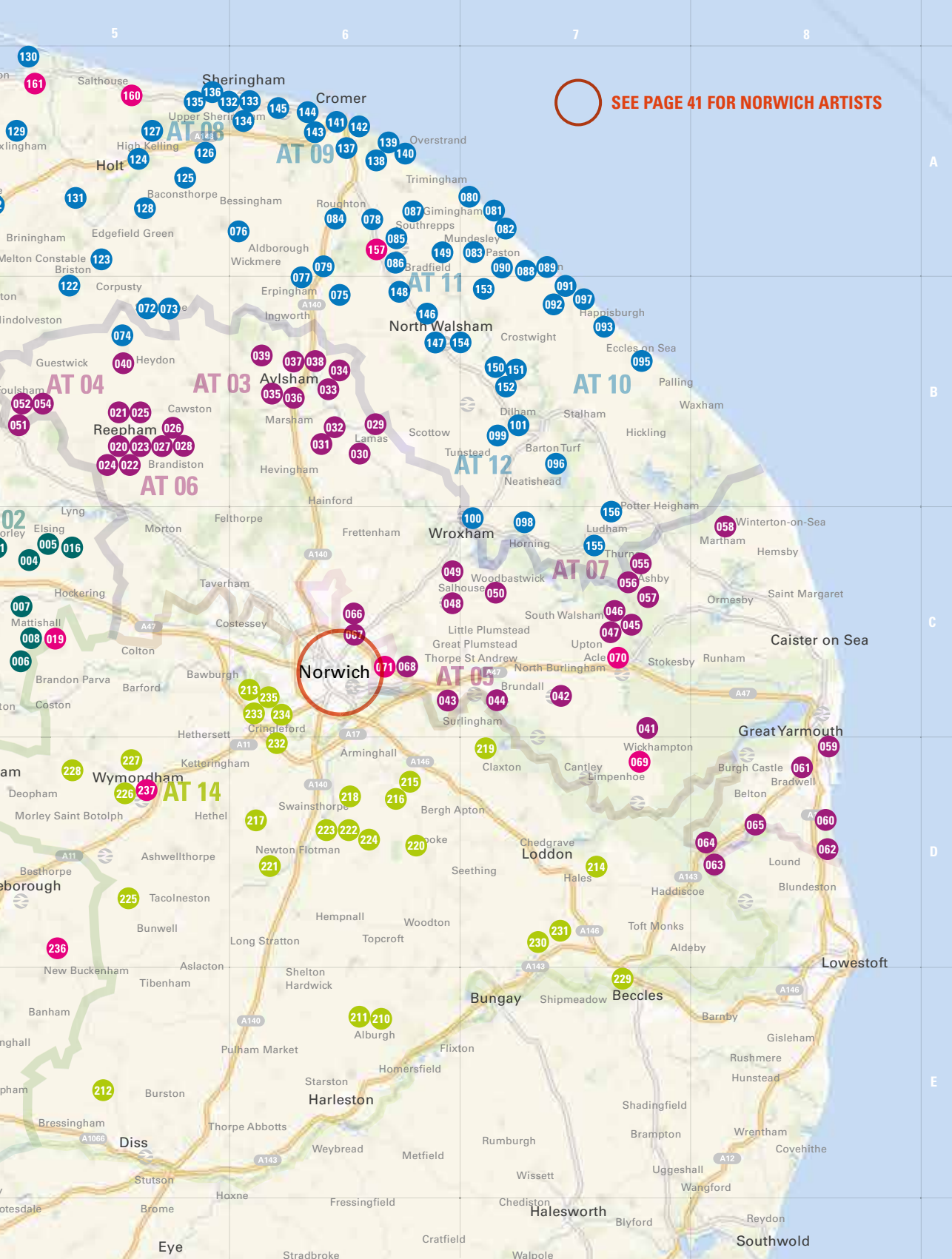
Over the years I have experimented with a variety of techniques but recently I've concentrated on linocuts and etchings. I'm inspired by the landscape and places I visit – fields of Tulips or just big skies and seascapes. My images usually start with a sketch and I like the print to evolve as I create it, in other words not working out too much detail in advance. I enjoy using my many years of experience to let the image develop in the direction it happens to take at that particular time - this is the most natural way for me to my work.

Next year I will be having my first retrospective exhibition and have previously had work in a number of renowned exhibitions, including the Summer Exhibition at the Royal Academy. I also teach drawing, painting and printmaking classes on a regular basis.

We moved to this part of West Norfolk two years ago and built my studio onto the back of the house. This will be my second year taking part in Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios. I find the scheme a wonderful way to feel part of a bigger artist's community and a great way to invite people to come and see my work.

Each entry includes the artist's name and address plus the dates their studio is open and a description of their artwork. Details are written and supplied by the artist.

An alphabetical index of artists is available at the back of this guide.

Art Trails are numbered **AT01** to **AT16**. Trail details can be found at the end of the relevant district's section. The AT number can be found on the map, to indicate the trail area. Trail maps are available from the participating studios, and downloadable from the Open Studios website.

Norfolk schools also participate in Norfolk & Norwich Open Studios. Please take some time to visit these schools – to support their budding young artists, and to celebrate the visual arts and creativity within schools. 19 schools are taking part this year and are listed at the end of each district. Their brochure ID numbers are shown in pink on the maps.

W A green wheelchair symbol means that there is a parking space at least 3.6m wide, doors at least 0.75m wide and a level entrance (with no steps or thresholds greater than 20mm high).

A An amber symbol means the studio has limited, partial or no access. Visitors should phone ahead to discuss the issues and make any additional access arrangements.

R A red symbol means the studio is not accessible to wheelchair users. Visitors should phone ahead to discuss access possibilities.

Remember, as most studios are private and are not open to the public throughout the year, it is unlikely that they will have adapted or wheelchair-accessible toilets.

Further details about visitor access to studios can be found on the website in the artist's listing. However, if you are in any doubt about access to a studio it's always recommended that you call the artist in advance.
